April 17 -- "Going Shopping at the Market" at King Kullen Supermarket

A behind the scenes tour, then shopping for your mini market list. Cost to cover market list (3-4 items only please.)

April 24 -- "My Very Own Pet" Day at Pet Supplies Plus

Learn how to care for your pet (goldfish) then shop for your own fish, bowl and supplies to take home. Cost is \$5-\$8 per child.

May 8 -- "Let's Meet at the Library" at The Manhasset Public Library

Tour the Manhasset Library, have story and craft time, then get your own library card and take out a book. Cost: \$5 per child.

May 15--"Picnic/Park/Play" at Mary Davis Green (Raindate May 22)

It's a picnic social in the town park so bring a picnic lunch and a blanket—we'll play games, explore the playground, and visit the Ice Cream Truck. Cost \$3.50-\$4 (ice cream truck purchase.)
